Covid Requirements: Check in screening, frequent hand washing, and mask wearing will be required during camp. Parents will notify camp director of child absence during camp and agree to keep child at home if screening questions apply. Kids will be divided into multiage groups with their family members (brothers and sisters will be together this year to limit exposure). Kids will stay in original groups for the 4 days of camp. Camper groups will be limited to 15 people or less including adult and youth volunteers. Groups will remain socially distanced from other groups during the camp. Snacks and water will be served during camp. When snacks are served campers may remove their masks but will be assigned designated spots for eating and drinking at least 6 feet from other campers. Snacks will be prepackaged and individually wrapped. The camp will be held outdoors on the parish property and children will need to dress for the weather. Singing will also be done 6 feet from other campers with masks on. Children will not remain at any one station for longer than 30 minutes during the camp.
