

SACRISTAN RESPONSIBILITIES BEFORE MASS

(Arrive ½ hour before mass begins)

Large Tray: (Fill Then Place on Credence Table):

5:00 Mass: 3 Patens (bowls) + Father's
5 Cups + Father's Chalice
5 Purificators + Father's for his Chalice

8:30 Mass: 4 Patens (bowls) + Father's
8 Cups + Father's Chalice
8 Purificators + Father's for his Chalice

10:30 Mass: 5 Patens (bowls) + Father's
8 Cups + Father's Chalice
8 Purificator + Father's for his Chalice

+Each Mass: Large Host on the small paten, place it on top of Father's
Chalice & cover with the small white square
Fill the small carafe with water
Tabernacle Key – leave on tray or put in tabernacle keyhole

Gift Table: (In back of the church):

5:00 Mass: 150 unconsecrated hosts + Wine Carafe (1" wine)

8:30 Mass: 200 unconsecrated hosts + Wine Carafe (1" wine)

10:30 Mass: 250 unconsecrated hosts + Wine Carafe (1" wine)

Credence Table: Washing Bowl with Water
White Hand Towel

Sacristin Changes:

1. Pour the wine to be consecrated into the cups before mass. Then place the tray on the credence table.
2. Pour only a ^{1"} ~~small amount~~ into the small cruet. Place that on the gift table in back of the church, along with the bread to be consecrated. (Need extra in cruet for 2 CL)

Altar Server Changes:

1. Hold the book for Father Vu – be aware when this is to be done.
2. Be careful when taking the tray to the altar to set up for communion. The wine is now poured into the cups so the tray may be a little heavier.
3. Both servers will walk down the front of the altar along with Father Vu and receive the gifts from the family before communion. One takes the bread, one the wine and places them on the altar... One of you to the left and one to the right of the altar.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PURIFIER OF SACRED VESSELS

Purification is accomplished in the following order:

1. All the vessels used for the Body and Blood of Christ are placed on the tray on the credence table at the conclusion of the Communion Rite. The Deacon or 2cr will cover them with a cloth for the remainder of the Mass.

Steps 2 – 4 takes place at the credence table immediately following the Mass.

2. The host bowls or patens are held over the chalice and wiped with the fingers to cause any particles/fragments of the Body of Christ to be deposited in the chalice.
3. Water is then put in the wine flagen to dilute any remaining Consecrated Wine (Blood of Christ). This water is then swirled around inside the flagon and the resulting mixture is then poured into the chalice to combine with the fragments of the Body of Christ. The combined diluted Blood of Christ and the Body of Christ are then consumed. .
4. Water is added to each of the other communion cups to dilute any remaining Blood of Christ. This diluted Blood of Christ is then consumed by the designated purifier.
5. The sacred vessels are now brought into the sacristy to be washed. This general washing will be done in the regular sink by 3cr and 3cl Eucharistic Ministers.
6. The designated purifier will rinse with plain water the purificators and the corporals in the sacrarium. Please ring these out very well and hang on the rack in the bride's room. They will then be ready for general laundering and care.
