Hello SBA Families!

Last month we read and heard more great stories. We expressed our own "songs" with The Baby BeeBee Bird. Ask your child what the baby beebee bird's song sounded like (if they forgot, it was a never-ending beebeebobbibobbi), and ask what their song might sound like. We explored how our five senses can help us learn about the world after reading Seven Blind Mice. Ask your child what the blind mice thought some of the different parts of the elephant were—the leg (a pillar), the ear (a fan), the trunk (a snake), the tail (a rope). We experienced a different method of storytelling as Mrs. Fenelon told the story of Abiyoyo instead of reading it. And finally, we read The Salamander Room, and talked about habitats and created a home for our own salamander friend.

This month in Storybook Adventure we will be reading several Fairy tales and Fables. Through these timeless pieces we will find the moral of the story and talk about ways those lessons might apply to us. And we will explore storytelling through theater by presenting a very short presentation of The Three Little Pigs for you in our SBA classroom (Room 6) on Wednesday, March 20th, at noon.
