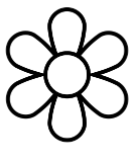


4'S CLASS APRIL NEWSLETTER

SJV Spring break is April 8-12. I hope you have a wonderful week and enjoy the extra time with your sweet kiddos!



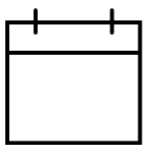
DRESS FOR THE WEATHER
