



# FR. BRAD HAGELIN

My dear Kirkland Catholics,

Pope Francis said this:

*“Marriage, according to Christian revelation, is a gift from God to the spouses... Matrimony is always a gift! Conjugal fidelity rests on divine fidelity; conjugal fruitfulness is based on divine fruitfulness. Man and woman are called to accept this gift and freely correspond to it with the reciprocal gift of self.”* — to members of the Roman Rota, Jan. 27, 2023.

This “semester” our parish family is going to be focusing on vocations, specifically the vocation to marriage. Fr. Val and I will launch a synchronized homily series over five weeks from the weekend of January 17 up until the Sunday before Lent. Then we are tentatively planning a marriage enrichment retreat for our parish family members the final weekend of May this year.

The reason for the focus on the vocation to marriage is that the vocation of marriage or lack of it affects every person, be it a child in a loving traditional family, to an single adult child-of-divorce, to a couple working through a rocky marriage, to a celibate ministering within families and to parishioners. The precipitous decline of baptized Catholics seeking the Sacrament of Matrimony and instead cohabitating or engaging in civil marriage only has been the most massive Sacramental “trend” in the American Church over the past thirty or so years. This certainly forebodes badly for both the health of these marriages but more to the point the “average” lived Faith of these couples at least at the time they are civilly married.

Our parish family could fairly claim to be the “parish family of vocations” in our Archdiocese given that joined together are “Holy Family” and Saint John Vianney (who is the Patron Saint of priests). Vocations have to be said yes to on a daily basis to be lived well, and it is our hope that our collective consciousness as a parish family will be raised about the importance of this Sacrament, and the importance of those elements that inevitably lead to healthy marriages. Let us reflect in this period of time on our own commitments and how we live those in union with the Lord Jesus, asking for His grace, healing, and elevation of all that is properly human into that which shares in the divine.






## FIRST RECONCILIATION & FIRST EUCHARIST PREPARATION 2026

We invite families to begin this year's Sacramental Preparation journey with us!  
Sessions begin:

- **January 23 at 7:00 pm**, or
- **January 24 at 10:00 am**

Parents and children attend together, and each session is offered twice to support busy schedules.

### PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

- Children must know the **Hail Mary** and **Our Father** by heart before First Reconciliation.
- Knowing one of the **Acts of Contrition** is recommended.
- Children should regularly attend either:
  - **Children's Liturgy of the Word** at the 11 am Sunday Mass, or
  - **Catholic Kids Catechism Club**

Children around age 7 must complete the Reconciliation curriculum before beginning First Eucharist preparation.

### PROGRAM FEE:

A \$80 supply fee per child is requested.

# CHILDREN AND FAMILY LIFE

**PARISH NURSERY:** While we love having children at Mass with our community, if you need some focused time, our nursery is available for children 18 months through 4 years old. It is staffed Sundays during the 9:00am and 11:00am Masses. The nursery is located downstairs. Parents are welcome to stay with their children if it makes them more comfortable. Audio from Mass can be heard in the nursery.



**CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD (CLOW):** Children are invited to join us for dismissal during the Sunday 11:00am Mass. The children hear the Gospel and have an opportunity to break it open with discussion, activities, and other stories that relate to the Gospel. No registration required and parents are welcome to accompany their children if they'd like. Children's Liturgy of the Word runs all year.

**CHILDREN'S MINISTRY VOLUNTEERS:** We could sure use help at CKCC on Sunday Mornings! We have so many Catechism Club members our Clubhouse leaders need support! We have some fabulous Catechists who present the weekly challenge to the kids but they need a helping hand. Please let Laura Stanger know if you are the answer to her prayer. Anyone who volunteers to work with children or vulnerable adults must do a criminal background check and complete the Safe Environment Program to keep everyone safe - the volunteers, kids, and the church. We are so very grateful for all of those who are willing to take the steps needed to work with our children. The program is now done online. Log on to [virtus.org](http://virtus.org) to check your status if you are already a volunteer, there may be some updates you need to make. If you are a new volunteer, log on and create a password. If you have any questions please ask Laura Stanger in the office.

**THANK YOU FOR YOUR DONATIONS!** For CKCC's December service project, we stuffed 100 blessing bags for the homeless again this year. Thank you for your help!

**CATHOLIC KIDS' CATECHISM CLUB:** Our faith formation program began in October but you can join any time. Kids 3 years old through 5th grade are welcome. 3 year olds to kindergarteners come on Sunday mornings during the 9:00am Mass for faith formation, where they will learn about the Mass. Our older kids, grades 1-5, can attend Catechism Club on Sunday mornings from 9:55-10:55am or Monday evenings from 7:00-8:00pm for an active, faith-filled, and joy-filled learning experience. Kids are divided into clubhouses based on grade levels. Each clubhouse completes challenges based on the curriculum set by the Archdiocese for their grade. ## **FIRST RECONCILIATION & EUCHARIST PREPARATION:**

We are making an important and significant change to sacramental preparation to align with Archdiocesan requirements. Children who would like to receive first communion next school year, 2026-27, must regularly participate in CKCC or Children's Liturgy of the Word this school year. ## AFGHAN REFUGEE FAMILY UPDATE

Nabila's family spent the final week of 2025 alternating work schedules to be able to have one of them home with their four children during the school holiday. They weathered the colds going through the family and became creative in learning the art of Tillamook toasted cheese sandwiches - an easy lunch for all the kids!

Shamila continues her maternity leave, and she and Bilal are working out the challenges of limited income and hoping to augment the situation with rideshare work. Learning the importance of credit-building and maintaining it, along with tax implications, has become a priority.

With the repatriation of many Afghans to their home country, the World Food Program warns of crisis level hunger this winter in Afghanistan due to severe cuts in international aid along with the country's struggling economy, recurrent droughts, and two recent deadly earthquakes. The families here struggle to provide support for their family still in Afghanistan and pray for their safety. Your continued prayers are sincerely appreciated.
