Hello SBA Families!

Last month we read the great classic story, *Blueberries for Sal*. We also read and listened to the wonderful song, *What a Wonderful World*, sung by Louis Armstrong. We talked about what makes the world wonderful to us and created a beautiful mural inspired by the song. Look for our mural in the hallway on the way to the SBA cubby area. Next we read the story of *Anansi the Spider*. Ask your child if they can remember any of Anansi's talented sons' names and how they helped him. (They were See Trouble, Road Builder, River Drinker, Game Skinner, Stone Thrower, and Cushion) After the story, we talked about our own talents and came up with a "talent name" based on what we are good at doing or really like doing. Some examples from class: Trampoline Jumper, Singer Dancer, Puzzle Maker, Mom & Dad Cuddler. And finally, we read *The Lion and the Mouse*, one of Aesop's Fables, and talked about the lessons we can learn from stories.

This month in Storybook Adventure we have more great stories and fun adventures planned. We will read several fairy tales. And we will experience storytelling through theater by acting out a couple of stories and preparing a very short performance of *The Three Little Pigs* for you in our SBA classroom (Room 6) on Wednesday, April 29th, at noon.
